

PUBLIC HEARING

It was announced by the President that notice had been given that the Acadia Parish Police Jury would hold a public hearing on Tuesday, January 13, 2009, at 6:00 P.M., Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, Louisiana, to receive comments on the Louisiana Long-Term Community Recovery Program.

Mr. Danny Magee of Hunt, Guillot & Associates, LLC, discussed the requirements of the public hearing being held to provide the public the opportunity to hear the Police Jury's proposed plans for the use of the LCDBG Disaster Recovery funding and the priority of all the proposed projects. It was noted that the public notice for the hearing was being published in the local newspaper on Wednesday, December 24, 2008, indicating the hearing to be held at 6:00 pm on January 13, 2009.

Projects discussed during the Public Hearing were:

Administrative/Public Safety Building
CDBG Funds: \$471,769.00

Generators for infrastructure
CDBG Funds: \$160,000.00

Mr. Credeur requested comments from the members of the public attending the Public Hearing. All comments received were in full support of the Acadia Parish Police Jury's efforts and their prioritizing of the proposed projects.
